The WFH Humanitarian Aid Programs

The WFH Humanitarian Aid Program provides factor donations to many countries around the world. These donations help people with bleeding disorders (PWBDs) enjoy a better quality of life.

Currently HWSK is running 4 Humanitarian Aid programs:

- **On Demand Treatment Program**

In 2021, the On-Demand program made it possible for people with bleeding disorders (PWBDs) to undergo multiple major and minor surgeries, endoscopies, RTA, IC bleeds and GI bleeds. The purpose of On-Demand treatment is to make available factor concentrates in cases of heavy bleeds and emergencies to save precious bleed time of hemophiliac patients.

- **Low Dose Prophylaxes Program**

In LDP program, 25 hemophilia children have been enlisted who fall in the range of one to twelve years. The aim of this program is to give treatment two times per week so that blood clotting factor levels are constantly maintained, hence joints are protected from disabilities.



- **Hemlibra Prophylaxes Program**

Hemlibra is an antibody therapy designed to combine factors IX and X of the blood clotting series and promote clotting. Restoring the missing function of factor VIII by an alternative method, which makes Hemlibra beneficial for the treatment of hemophilia -A patients, currently 35 patients are registered for this program.

- **Home Treatment Program**

At this point in time there are only Karachi hemophilia treatment center in the entire Sindh province, so it is a challenge making CFCs available for patients living in the far reaching corners of the province. For this purpose we enrolled 45 patients that live up to 150Kms away from us so that factors are made available at their doorstep in order to tackle emergency situations and heavy bleeds before they travel far towards Karachi.

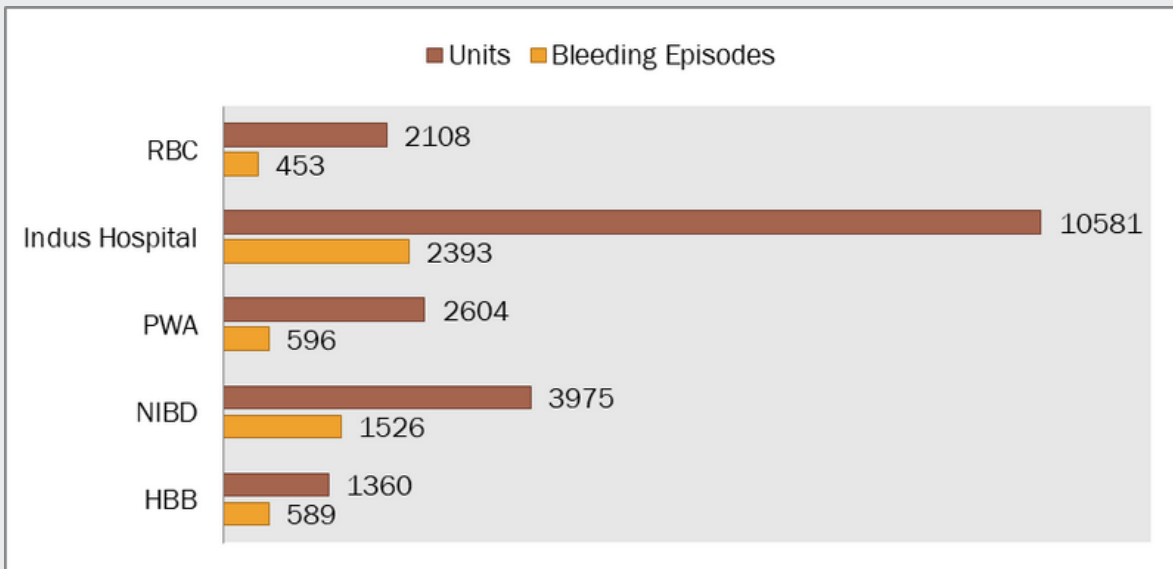

Blood by Product Cyroprecipitate & Fresh Frozen Plasma

In Pakistan, hemophilia and other bleeding disorders' treatment is not available in govt. hospitals. Whatever support is available is through the Hemophilia Welfare Society Karachi, with whatever resources were available with it.

To ease the pain of our registered patients, HWSK has built an effective network of donations with Indus Hospital, NIBD Blood Bank, Hussaini Blood Bank, PWA and Regional Blood Centers in order to make available internationally standardized screened plasma treatment for our Hemophilia community.

Education & Rehabilitation Through SOL Program

Save One Life (SOL) is an international nonprofit that provides direct financial assistance to children who bear the double burden of a bleeding disorder and poverty.

Partnering with bleeding disorder patient organizations in 14 developing countries which are Bangladesh, Cambodia, Dominican Republic, Ghana, Honduras, India, Kenya, Nepal, Nigeria, Pakistan, Philippines, Romania, Uganda.

Save One Life supports more than 1,700 children and youth through its sponsorship program to create new opportunities through post-secondary education. Save One Life also offers scholarship programs for young people with bleeding disorders in the countries they serve.

Save One Life was founded in 2001 by pioneer Laureen A. Kelley, parent of a son with hemophilia and president of LA Kelley Communications.

Currently, 23 beneficiaries are enrolled from HWSK in this program who receive funds for their educational expenses from SOL.

As per every year this year also the Save One Life (SOL) fund, earmarked for continuation of education for our deserving bleeding disorder patients. On this occasion of funds distribution, the chief guest was Secretary, Sindh Blood Transfusion Authority (SBTA) govt. of Sindh, Dr. Dur-e-Naz.

She appreciated SOL support and HWSK's efforts in this direction, underpinning the need for it to make the patients a vibrant part of the society at large and be able to earn sustenance for themselves and for their families as well.



WFH Humanitarian Aid Received in Karachi

For the first time this year HWSK made it possible for the shipment consignment of clotting factor concentrates (CFCs) from the World Federation of Hemophilia to land in Karachi, amid the Covid-19 global scenario. The situation was further compounded by the fact that the consignment had to be cleared from the customs at least six months before its expiry date.

For one, we didn't have the form 2(36) (c), which was required for the shipment, if it has to be exempted from all duties and taxes. For second, to let 2(36) (c) go into process we first had to be registered in Pakistan Center of Philanthropy (PCP). For third, we had to have the NOC from Drug Regulatory Authority of Pakistan (DRAP) and we also needed a WeBOC.

We didn't have any of these documents with us since we were doing it for the first time, to get the medicines cleared from the customs and the permission granted to us by which we were to be authorized to get shipments of medicines from abroad.

Had it not been for the Providence to come to our rescue, it would not be possible for us to get the things done in on such a short notice. But by the grace of God we were able to get all the formalities done in a remarkably short time and got the medicine cleared from the customs.



HWSK's Women Group Empowered Women with Bleeding Disorders

HWSK women's group consists of Women with Bleeding Disorders, lady doctors and they are very active in their activities.

HWSK Women Group actively works for their treatment, awareness, rehabilitation, moral and legal support. Our women group provides support in setting up small businesses for women who suffer from financial and psychological problems and they take care of their children themselves. Such activities by the HWSK women group are making the lives easier of women with bleeding disorder.



Meeting With SBTA (Sindh Blood Transfusion Authority) For Treatment Provision in Rural Areas.

In 2021 HWSK started an outreach drive in Sindh province (division wise) in order to establish more HTC's in far reaching areas of the province.

To make this initiative successful and sustainable we are already in liaison with the govt. of Sindh to give us a place attached with a hospital, preferably, so that the rent and electricity become free and the Regional Blood Centers to provide much-needed Cryos to these HTC's.

The CFC's are already being provided to us by World Federation of Hemophilia (WFH). If this is successfully implemented then it will be a win-win situation, both for the patients and HWSK.

In order to make this initiative fruitful we met Dr. Zahid Hasan Ansari, Secretary Sindh Blood Transfusion Authority (SBTA) govt. of Sindh to this effect and he had agreed to help us out in those areas. The govt. is also agreeing to procure CFC's from their resources and Regional Blood Centers and give CFC's to these HTC's which would further improve the quality of treatment for the hemophiliacs of Sindh.

After the meeting we presented Dr. Zahid with a shield on his continuous support for the cause of hemophilia treatment in Sindh.



Commending Dr. Dur-e-Naz For Her Struggle in The Bleeding Disorder Community.

We had a meeting with Director-Sindh Blood Transfusion Authority, Dr. Dur-e-Naz with regard to the hemophilia treatment in Sindh. We at HWSK believe that the presence of Dr. Dur-e-Naz is of utmost blessing for us.

Ever since she came to know about HWSK and the work that we do for the bleeding disorder community, she has never left our side and has taken us by the hand and enabled us to take actions towards the establishment of strong advocacy avenues with the govt. of Sindh.

We wanted to commend her for her effective efforts towards serving the bleeding disorder community and presented her with the shield on behalf of Novo Nordisk Haemophilia Foundation (NNHF) through the aegis of Hemophilia Foundation - Pakistan (HFP) as an acknowledgement for services given to bleeding disorder community during the Covid-19 pandemic.



HWSK Moved Towards Topline Govt. Advocacy

This year we had a very productive meeting with the minister Mr. Sajid Jochio of Ministry of Social Welfare, govt. of Sindh.

He has been associated with the hemophilia organizations' for a long time and we had found him very forthcoming whenever we invited him to attend Hemophilia Welfare Society's different activities/seminars.

During the meeting we discussed with him about broadening our scope of hemophilia activity from the city of Karachi to the whole of Sindh province so that we be able to take the treatment and education facilities to the hemophiliacs and at their doorsteps rather than they coming from the interior of Sindh and travel all the way to Karachi to get treatment.

For this purpose, we need to get our organization to be registered at the province level.

During the meeting, he also listened sympathetically to the challenges faced by the women, suffering from the bleeding disorder to help them become skilled in any trade so by virtue of that they can become an active bread earner for their families.

Mr. Sajid agreed on it in principle and had asked us to submit to him a written proposal to this effect so that in future meetings this could also come up for discussion at the govt. level and some concrete steps are taken in this direction.



Hemophilia & Disability Certificate

This year HWSK took another big leap towards the issuance of disability certificates for hemophiliacs of Sindh.

According to our patient's Registry Data, there are 60% of hemophilia sufferers who are physically deformed without adequate treatment. And all of these patients are over 30 years old. Most are from rural areas.

So, to raise the attention of the govt. towards the issuance of disability certificates we met with Mr. Muhammad Al-Nasir Deputy Director, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities.

He welcomed us kind heartedly with open arms and promised to arrange a meeting for us with DG. Sindh in the forth coming weeks in order to implement this disability criteria all over the province of Sindh for patients with bleeding disorders.



Raising Awareness about Hemophilia among Common People

Awareness of Hemophilia is negligible in Pakistan and there are no official state sponsored awareness groups working to raise awareness.

Most people are unaware of the name of the disease, so diagnosis and management presents unique challenges to Hemophiliacs. To raise awareness towards this grave issue in the society, HWSK's youth group, consisting of hemophiliacs developed, distributed literature and briefed about Hemophilia in crowded places and mosques.



World Hemophilia Day WHD2021

A very important awareness session was held with the budding doctors of Iqra University - North Campus .

We feel thankful towards Dr. Rabiqa Saleem & IU management in pulling off a spectacular awareness seminar, which is no small feat in itself considering the specter of Covid looming large on the city of Karachi.

Hemophilia Welfare Society Karachi (HWSK) had the honor of commemorating this day with the Iqra University students. Dr. Munira Borhany , a consultant hematologist working with HWSK for the hemophilia cause informed the students about the disease, its prognosis, and what the hemophilia society is doing in the province of Sindh in ameliorating the suffering and pain of the hemophilia community.

Raheel Ahmed , a driving force behind HWSK, one of the founding members of the hemophilia society, which conceived the idea of making a hemophilia society working in the province of Sindh, whose aim would be in improving the plight of the hemophilia community.

During the session , he shed some light on what society is doing in making it known to the people who matter in the government in order for them to do something in bringing about a qualitative change in the lives of hemophiliacs by opening hemophilia treatment centers (HTCs) throughout the government of Sindh hospitals so that the hemophiliacs get the treatment close to their home and do not have to travel, with each bleeding episode, to Karachi for treatment, thus reducing the complications, which otherwise results due to the late response in getting the treatment.

He also enlightened the audience about the statistics with regard to the prevalence of hemophilia in the province and the aims and objectives, both long and short term, of the society to see to it that each and every hemophiliac gets the best possible treatment under the given circumstances and to pool resources for that.



Advocacy with Social Welfare Department Govt. of Sindh

Hemophilia Welfare Society is the only organization in Sindh which is run by the affected patients and their parents and is providing free treatment, education and other facilities according to world class standards.

Madam Kishwar Shabana, Additional Director of Social Welfare Department visited our organization. She met patients and their families throughout her visit to our center and appreciated the services and facilities provided by HWSK. She met with our Women's Group and appreciated their services. she also met our women's group and listened to their considerations paying attention and she assured them of his full support. After that Dr. presented a shield to approbation on her services for bleeding disorder community.



Capacity Building with Timax Health Sciences

The role of pharmaceutical companies is very important in sustainable supply of clothing factor concentrates in Pakistani to supply of CFCs in markets & private, public hospitals. In this purpose we are advocating with pharmaceutical and inviting them to visit our hemophilia treatment Center.

So, we are very thankful to Mr. Rana Nadeem , Rana Kaleem and Syed Arshad from Timax Health science for their visit and appreciation and supporting us.



Capacity Building with Popular International

In Pakistan, coagulation factor concentrates are very expensive or unavailable, the reason is that its registration from DRAP is very difficult, Being an extremely expensive injection, it is beyond the reach of every rich and poor person. And that's why pharmaceutical companies don't work on it.

It's a great honor for us that Manager Marketing Mr. Mirza Zahid Hussain of Popular International (Pvt.) Ltd a renowned distributor of many renowned International companies has donated us 50 Vials of clotting Factor-VIII concentrates (CFCs).

This will tremendously boost our capacity to provide CFCs to the hemophiliacs registered with us. We are thankful his for such a generous donation.



Appreciation of our Services by Hussaini Blood Bank

HWKS has a model hemophilia treatment center in Karachi, where many patients come for treatment from different districts of the province and as well the whole country, Because it is the only treatment center of its kind in Pakistan where the best treatment facilities are provided free of cost according to the world standard and because of this there is a large number of patients who come to avail these facilities.

Delegations from Husaini Hematology & Oncology trust consisting of medical students and doctors often visits these facilities and met with patients.



Capacity Building with PWA

We warmly welcomed Patients' Welfare Association-PWA to our Bleeding Disorder Health Network.

PWA is the largest non-political student-run welfare organization in Pakistan, located in Civil Hospital Karachi, being run solely by the volunteer students of Dow Medical College.

HWSK is providing free of cost treatment to all bleeding disorder patients including Hemophilia through the support of collaborative organizations.

We have a large number of registered people suffering from other bleeding disorder diseases like rare factor deficiency 1, 7, 10, 13, and platelet disorder.

We are providing screened blood by-products to them through the support of collaborative organizations like Husaini

Hematology & Oncology Trust(HHOT), National Institute Of Blood Diseases & Bone Marrow Transplantation (NIBD), The Indus Hospital and now, Now PWA is a new addition to our list of supporting hands through regular interactions with them.

We are very thankful to PWA team for their support and providing bulk supply of Fresh Frozen Plasma to us.



Capacity Building: Gambat Institute of Medical Sciences

HWSK brought good tidings for the patients who used travel hundreds of kilometers from the rural areas of Sindh to reach HWSK Hemophilia Treatment Center (HTC) based in Karachi for treatment. This journey is arduous, painful, demanding and there have been cases where the patients expired while on the way to Karachi.

To facilitate in ameliorating the pain and suffering of the fellow patients we embarked on a plan to visit Gambat Institute of Medical Sciences (GIMS), where Dr. M. Shehzad has been very active and is desirous of opening an HTC over there so that the hemophiliacs of the adjoining areas could come there for treatment.

GIMS, is the one of a kind tertiary care hospital established in the city of Gambat. There is no other hospital in Pakistan in the rural areas with such vast treatment facilities available for the general patients and now hemophiliacs would be another feather in their cap. This institute is well established in the field of hematology, Bone Marrow Transplant, Liver Transplant, Kidney Transplant, Stem Cell Therapy and a Rapid Response Center (ER) and this treatment is given free of cost.

We are planning to have more such HTCs in other areas of the province of Sindh. Mirpurkhas can be a case in point.

We have registration with us of about 100 patients who come from Gambat and surrounding areas. These 100 patients could be treated at GIMS. We made arrangements for the supply the cryos from Regional Blood Center (RBC) and coagulation factor concentrates (CFCs) could be supplied by us which we get from World Federation of Hemophilia Humanitarian Aid (WFH) through the aegis of Hemophilia Foundation - Pakistan (HFP) as per their protocol and criteria.



Our strategic plan is to have a private-public nexus in providing such state-of-the-art treatment.

HWSK received a request from Dr. Shehzad hematologist of Center of Haematology & Bone Marrow Transplant GIMS. He requested us to visit GIMS in the wake of our visit to Mirpurkhas. We at once set out for the visit to GIMS as part of our outreach plan, where we identified 72 more patients.

We are committed to providing treatment provided to the patients of the Khair Pur division including Gambat and its surrounding areas at the start of the New Year 2022 in collaboration with GIMS.



Capacity Building Activity: Mirpur Khas

HWSK organized a hemophilia outreach drive at District Mirpurkhas. The purpose of this visit was to facilitate many patients in remote areas of Sindh province living without adequate treatment.

We have always stood by our bleeding disorders community Mirpurkhas. HWSK identified numerous patients in remote areas of Sindh province and planned an outreach drive which aims to support them to get access of state-of-the-art treatment in their home town.

Through this outreach activity at district Mirpurkhas, we registered 70 new patients of hemophilia and provided CFCs (Anti hemophilia injections) at their doorstep through the support of Hemophilia Foundation Pakistan, World Federation of Hemophilia / Federación Mundial de Hemofilia humanitarian aid.

We are very thankful to the Hemophilia welfare society Mirpurkhas team for their hospitality and respect and are hopeful towards the development of a mutually beneficial relationship under the hemophilia plight.

We are also grateful to Dr. Dogar Sham and Mr. Lal Chand for their assistance and facilities in organizing the awareness seminar in District Mirpur Khas.



Increment in Storage Capacity

The ever increasing hemophilia registry requires for a state-of-the-art treatment facility and state-of-the-art treatment requires for effective storage planning. The HWSK facility currently utilizes 4000 blood products averagely per month.

To successfully deliver our utilization requirement HWSK currently houses 3Nos of Bio-medical refrigerators capable of freezing clotting factor concentrates at 2°C to 8°C. For the storage of blood derived FFPs, CPs and CS products, HWSK has acquired 4Nos of freezers capable of preserving fresh blood products at -40°C to -80°C.

Additionally, HWSK houses an international standard automatic CryoFuge consisting of 8buckets that revolve at 4000RMP for component making. HWSK is the only Hemophilia treatment facility in the country with a CryoFuge capable of maintaining blood products a 37°C. This machine thaws the product proteins in such a way that it minimizes the chances of blood reactions completely.



Free of Cost Pharmacy Services

Hemophilia treatment doesn't only depend on providing clotting factor concentrates and a comprehensive treatment facility provides complete care. When patients loose blood they tend to develop weaknesses and other conditions that effect vitals which are essential for their physical upkeep.

Keeping this in mind, the HWSK facility houses a pharmacy capable of providing free of charge supporting medication to patients who are not able to afford them. Our pharmacy is well maintained and equipped to provide oral painkillers, coagulation supporting medicine and vitamin regimens that help support recovery and joint upkeep to prevent further bleeds.



Media Coverage Activities Amidst Covid Restrictions

The year 2021 presented several unique challenges as the Covid-19 threat loomed large and because of this conducting physical awareness activities became difficult. But determined as we are, we did not let external factors stop our awareness building activities.

The HWSK team represented itself on numerous media outlets throughout the year where appeals to the government were also made to provide Covid-19 vaccines at our doorstep so that our patients do not have to stand in long queues to get Covid jabs.

We received a positive repose from different state officials and we were able to successfully execute Covid-19 vaccination drives for our patients, under the cover of factor concentrates, solely through our media awareness efforts.



Our Plan For 2022

- HWSK aims to build Strong advocacy with the government as well as with the private sector.
- To establish Hemophilia Treatment Center–HTC in Hyderabad division and other remote areas, through outreach to provide treatment facilities at the doorstep.
- HWSK aims to increase their capabilities to maintain and improve quality of life by establishing a comprehensive physiotherapy unit.
- To disseminate awareness through Continuing Medical Education–CME by conducting seminars and workshops into the medical and educational institution.
- To established a pharmacy to provide anther medicine as well Anti- Hemophilia Injection and Blood by products.
- HWSK aims to magnify Hemophilia Advocacy on Electronic and Print Media.
- To startregistration of Hemophilia Carrier women for effective future planning and awareness.
